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2 ENROLLED, An Act,

3 To require any county for which the Department of  
4 Forensic Sciences performs the duties of the county coroner or  
5 county medical examiner to pay the cost of the services  
6 provided by the Department; and to provide for the  
7 distribution of the remittance.


8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of  
10 law, in any county in which the Department of Forensic  
11 Sciences performs the duties of the county coroner or county  
12 medical examiner pursuant to local law, the county commission  
13 shall pay to the Department each year the cost of the services  
14 provided by the Department, as determined by the Department.  
15 Payments from the county shall be made by the tenth day of  
16 each month to the Department of Forensic Sciences and shall be  
17 deposited into the Alabama Forensic Services Trust Fund. In  
18 the event a county does not pay the amounts required by this  
19 act, the Department shall not be required to perform the  
20 duties or responsibilities of the coroner or medical examiner  
21 for that county.


22 Section 2. All laws or parts of laws which conflict  
23 with this act are repealed.

1                   Section 3. This act shall become effective October  
2                   1, 2012, following its passage and approval by the Governor,  
3                   or its otherwise becoming law.
